Scarification of green by Bernard using his own equipment. Club member will follow clearing debris with club rotary petrol mower and cylinder mower. Other members will empty grass box into wheelbarrows and remove to skip.

Covid 19 transmission	Volunteers Members of the public	<p>Social distancing strictly adhered to.</p> <p>Volunteer group size restricted to 6. The nature of the work means that there will be limited interaction between volunteers except when emptying the grassbox. However it should still be possible to maintain a 2m social distancing when doing this.</p> <p>The morning session will start at 9am and finish at 12noon, the afternoon session will start at 12.30 and finish at 3.30pm. A record of volunteers will be kept for contact tracing purposes.</p> <p>There will be a separate small group working in the clubhouse – cleaning surfaces, preparing for pump replacement. These volunteers will not mingle with the volunteers on the green.</p> <p>Wheelbarrow handles, grassbox, lawnmower handles etc. to be cleaned before use, again when operators change over and at the end of the session. Hand sanitiser to be available.</p> <p>Volunteers asked to bring own, clean gloves.</p> <p>Volunteers should bring their own food and drinks.</p>

<p>Manual Lifting Grassbox, wheelbarrows</p>	<p>Volunteers</p>	<p>Grassboxes and wheelbarrows to be emptied at regular intervals before they get heavy. Use of wheelbarrows avoids carrying heavy bags. Skip has a drop down door to facilitate emptying. Volunteers stationed at opposite ends of the green for grassbox emptying so that each volunteer has a regular break. Jobs should be swapped to avoid too much repetition but handles etc should be cleaned before swap over.</p>
<p>Lawnmower Use Two mowers in operation – Petrol driven cylinder Petrol driven rotary</p>	<p>Volunteers</p>	<p>Operators should be either experienced with the use of the machines, or have been instructed on their safe use and operation. Strong footwear must be worn. Ear defenders are available to reduce noise levels but must be cleaned before use. Green to be inspected for foreign objects that could be thrown out by the blades of the mower. Grassbox should not be removed until the blades have stopped rotating. If it is necessary to remove a blockage from the blades, the mower must be switched off. Mowers to be refuelled before the session starts. If it is necessary to refuel during a session, the mower should be removed from the green and allowed to cool before refilling.</p>
